

Good News – Royal Oak Township Water Main Replacement Project

In March of 2025, Royal Oak Township will be embarking on its largest infrastructure improvement project in recent memory. Over 8,000 linear feet of water main will be replaced in the Township at a cost of almost \$4.5 million dollars. Water mains approaching 100 years old will be replaced with new high-density polyethylene (HDPE) or ductile iron piping or lined with a cured-in-place pipe within a pipe system (CIPP). The Township was able to collect grant funding over three (3) fiscal years by means of six (6) separate grants from the State, Oakland County, and the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) to cover the entire cost of this project.

Work will take place along 8 Mile Rd. from Mendota to just east of Wyoming, Mendota from 8 Mile to Fitzgerald Pl., Pasadena from Mendota to Majestic, Cloverdale from Wyoming to Westview, Woodside from Royal Oak Towers to Northend and Glen Lodge from south of Pasadena to Bates. The Contractor has mobilized to the site and has begun construction. Homes within the project area may be impacted with short-term water supply disruptions and boil water notices while the Contractor is making their connections from the old water main to the new water main. These communications will be delivered using door hangers by the Oakland County Water Resources Commissioner's office (WRC). These disruptions will be kept to a minimum, however, if you have an extenuating circumstance in which you need fresh water, please contact the Township's on-site field representative or e-mail the address at the bottom. Please be patient with the dust and noise and drive safely through the work zones. Construction is anticipated to take 2-3 months for the water main installations and then another 1-2 months to restore all the pavement, sidewalks, and turf grass.
